Introduction

The Walpole Coordinated Family and Community Engagement Program (Walpole CFCE) is a community based program funded through the Department of Early Education and Care which provides family support to Walpole families with children birth through school age.

There are five main goals of the Walpole CFCE program:

1. Increase knowledge of and accessibility to high-quality early education and care programs and services for families with children prenatal through school-age.
2. Promote parent education, family engagement and early literacy.
3. Facilitate collaboration and community planning between local early education and care partners and other community stake holders, including parents.
4. Provide support and information to families with children transitioning between and among early education and care settings, home and school, and
5. Support early education and care programs across the public and private sectors in delivering high-quality services.

Through direct services and/or referrals, the Walpole CFCE program provides a variety of services to Walpole families, which include:

Providing families access to: child development information; transition information and supports; assistance with meeting basic needs; timely support in periods of family crisis; high quality, specific and up-to-date information and referrals. family literacy and school readiness activities; family and community events; parent leadership opportunities; and information about early education and care opportunities and other community resources that support parents in their role as their child's first teacher.

Providing early education and care programs with: support in identifying program quality needs and accessing training and other professional development opportunities; opportunities to share best practices and coordinate resources, and linkages to technical assistance and local resources to assist them in meeting quality standards.

The Walpole Coordinated Family and Community Engagement program is please to present our newly revised Community Resource Guide 2011. The Resource Guide is a comprehensive listing of resources for Walpole and the surrounding communities and contains three main categories: educational services and resources, family support services, area recreation and activities.
